WHAT IS A MEMBERSHIP WEBSITE ANYWAY?

A membership website allows the site owner to limit access of actions performed on your site so that only logged in users can perform those actions. (ex: restriction of content OR replying to forum posts...)




WHAT YOU NEED TO BUILD YOUR MEMBERSHIP SITE

- 3) Start with text because it is easier to update than video or graphics.


